Update on town & city meetings:

- Town of Barksdale – Dennis contacted the Town Chair and plans to attend November meeting; Roy is willing to attend with Dennis
- Town of Bayfield - Planning Commission will be drafting a letter to present at the next town board meeting (10/15)
- Town of Bayview – at meeting on 10/9, town board voted in favor of sending letter to county in support of East Route

- City of Washburn – Roy & Lorraine attended 10/8 meeting; Roy provided an informational update on the project and will attend next month to ask for written support
